

Student Waiver

1. All bowlers must be USBC Certified, \$4 this season.
2. All high school matches are to be non-tobacco events.
3. Students must attend the school they bowl for. **They must meet the school's attendance and academic requirements for participation in athletics.** Exception: bowlers may not be 20 before August 1, 2018. All bowlers are subject to their school's policy for discipline.
4. Bowlers caught in any specified or illegal activity on the center property will be immediately suspended from the remainder of the day's activities. (These activities would include but not be limited to the use of tobacco, alcohol or illegal drugs.) Any and all other rule infractions will defer to the school policy for discipline.
5. Students must abide by USBC Rule #400. Members may not bowl, substitute or pace in any bowling activity which offers any of the following as prizes: 1) Cash or bonds, 2) Merchandise exceeding \$500 in value. First time offenders must seek reinstatement and serve a minimum 1-match suspension.
6. Un-sportsmanlike conduct, including but not restricted to deliberate foot fouls, taunting, vulgar language, or abuse of equipment or facilities, is not permitted.
7. Team competitors must appear in uniforms approved by the Commissioner/Coordinator for all matches and tournaments. The full set of 'Uniform Rules' is listed on pages 9, 10 & 11 of the **IHSB Rules 2018-19**. Bowlers need to know the rules and abide by them so they will be allowed to participate. Any exception to the written rule must be approved by the Commissioner/Coordinator.
8. No headsets (radios, Ipods, mp3's) or cell phones after competition starts.
