STRIKE FORCE LANES JUNIOR GOLD QUALIFIER RULES

1. This tournament is sanctioned by the USBC and all USBC tournament rules apply, including Rule 400. This is a scratch event.
2. Qualifier is open to any USBC certified youth bowler. Bowlers have the option of paying for their USBC Jr Gold membership either before the event or after earning their 2021 Junior Gold spot.
3. This qualifier is subject to cancellation if minimum participation levels are not satisfied. Cancellation will take place at least 24 hours prior.
4. **Entry fee is \$35 per bowler, as long as fees are paid by August 17, 2020. Entries paid after August 17, 2020 will be accessed a \$5 late fee.** All Checks should be made out to "STRIKE FORCE LANES". All returned checks will be charged a \$30.00 service charge unless bank error is proven.
5. Walk-ins are welcomed on a CASH-ONLY basis and based on lane availability.
6. Entry fee is broken down based on \$25.00 Jr. Gold qualifying and \$10.00 lineage/expenses.
7. Registered bowlers should arrive no later than 45 minutes prior to the start of the event or risk losing their spot in the tournament.
8. Walk-in entries will close 30 minutes prior to the start of the event. No refunds will be provided.
9. Bowlers will bowl a 4 game block, moving one pair of lanes to the right after each game.
10. A bowler arriving late will receive a zero for each frame missed.
11. Each bowler is responsible for recording/totaling his/her own scores on the recap sheet turned in to the tournament desk.
12. All scoring corrections must be made by a tournament official or bowling center employee.
13. In case of a tie for an advancing spot to Junior Gold, the bowlers will bowl a 1 game roll off.
14. All scoresheets will be verified and corrected, if needed, by the tournament staff. All disputed scores must be done through the tournament director with 72 hours of the completion of the competition.
15. Awards will be paid out as entries into the 2021 Junior Gold Championships in Indianapolis, IN and awarded on a 1:8 ratio (U20/U18), 1:6 ratio (U15) and 1:4 ratio (U12). This will provide the minimum number of bowlers required to have at least 1 bowler advancing per division. If there isn't a minimum number of bowlers for each division, bowlers will be offered to bowl in combined divisions or offered a refund. Award recipients are responsible for their own transportation, housing, meals, and expenses to attend the Jr Gold Championships.
16. Bowlers must wear a bowling shirt with a collared, V-neck, rib-lined or banded necklines. Mock collar must be a minimum of three-quarters of one inch (**no t-shirts or shirts with any alcohol or tobacco advertising are allowed**). Male participants are required to wear slacks or dress/golf shorts. Either one must not contain drawstring waists, elastic bottoms, or cargo pockets. Female participants are required to wear slacks, skirts, capris, skorts or walking shorts. All skirts, capris, skorts, or walking shorts must be below the competitor's fingertips when they are standing and their arms are hanging loosely at their side. **Jeans and yoga pants are not permitted.** Failure to adhere to the dress code may result in disqualification. Modifications to dress code may be made per the discretion of the tournament staff. **Bowlers MUST be in tournament attire at the time of check-in for inspection.**
17. Smoking, consumption of alcoholic beverages (regardless of age), chewing of tobacco, or using any non-prescription controlled substances is prohibited at all times while competition is taking place. Violators shall be disqualified. Anyone caught during the course of the event with any controlled substances (illegal drugs, etc.) will be disqualified and reported to the proper authorities.
18. All bowlers must remain poised during competition. Improper language, obscene gestures, and any other disruptive behavior will not be tolerated. Disqualification may result at the discretion of the Qualifier/Tournament Director(s).
19. Any damage to bowling center equipment by a bowler will result in disqualification from the event. The bowler will also be responsible for paying the establishment for any damages caused.
20. No use of electronics in the bowlers area or while bowling during competition. This includes CD Players, MP3 Players, Cell Phones, as well as hand-held video games. Devices that have a calculator function may be used only to tally scores. Fans are permitted.
21. There will be no altering of the surface of the bowling ball once event scoring has begun. The bowler may only use a dry towel to wipe off their ball. If the surface of a ball has been altered, the ball will be removed from competition.
22. The use of powder or easy slide on the soles of shoes will not be permitted. If a bowler is found violating this rule, a warning will be issued. Disregard of the warning will result in disqualification.
23. In consideration of the Tournament Director and Strike Force Lanes from any and all liability for any injury or accident involving entrant as a result of entrant participating therein.
24. All matters not covered by the rules and specifications herein shall be covered by USBC playing rules and specifications until the end of the 2019-2020 bowling season.
