## Dick Lyke “Grandpa Grouch” Scholarship Tournament Rules

1. **Eligibility:** This Tournament is open to all USBC certified youth bowlers participating in a certified youth league (including HIGH SCHOOL bowling programs). All youth bowlers participating in this tournament **MUST** have their USBC certification card present at check-in which is one hour prior to the start of the event. Walk-ins must check in at least thirty (30) minutes prior to the start of the tournament. To compete in this tournament, bowlers must meet eligibility requirements set by USBC Rule #400.
2. **Divisions:** There will be three (3) divisions – one (1) Scratch division (for all averages 191 and Above) and two (2) Handicap divisions (one for all averages 151 - 190 and one for all averages 150 and Below). **Bowlers in the higher Handicap division may elect to “bowl up” and bowl in the Scratch division.**
3. **Format:** All bowlers will bowl a four game qualifier. The first two games will be bowled on the assigned lanes at check-in; **bowlers will then move** to a designated pair of lanes within a four-lane block for the next two games. **Bowlers will cut to the top three (3) qualifiers** in each division for the step ladder finals (**boys and girls will not be separated**). In the Handicap Divisions step ladder rounds, handicap will be given for one game per match. Ties will be broken in the qualifying and step ladder rounds with a 9<sup>th</sup> and 10<sup>th</sup> frame roll off. The Jr Gold format will be the actual total of all four games without handicap. Ties will be broken with a 9<sup>th</sup> and 10<sup>th</sup> frame roll off. Bowlers who are tied for a qualifying spot in either event and leave the center will forfeit their opportunity for advancement.
4. **Handicap** will be 100% of the difference between the bowler’s average and 190 in the handicap divisions.
5. **Averages:** Bowlers will use their highest **current** USBC certified average for a minimum of 12 games. This includes all travel leagues, middle school and high school leagues. If there is no current average as of the time of bowling, the youth bowler will use their highest certified average from the **2016-2017** season. If no averages are verifiable, then the bowler will use an average of 190. **Bowlers must provide average verification. Current league standing sheets are required at check-in.**
6. **Jr Gold Membership:** All bowlers wishing to bowl the Jr Gold optional qualifier must be a Jr Gold member prior to competition. Membership applications/payment will be accepted prior to bowling in the competition.
7. **Jr Gold Spots** will be based on the division ratios listed on the entry form or major fraction thereof providing the minimum number of bowlers required to participate accounts for at least 1 per division. Jr Gold divisions are gender based unless there are not enough of one gender for a qualifier, then gender divisions may be combined.
8. **Early Bird Entry Fee** consists of the following: \$25.00 prize fund and \$20.00 administrative fees (additional prize funds may be added at any time). Entries received after February 4, 2018 will be \$55.00. An optional \$25.00 fee for all Jr. Gold entries (U12, U15, and U20 divisions).
9. **Scholarship** money will be paid to each division in at least a one in ten ratio (1 in 10). Disbursement of scholarship money will be handled through the SMART program account #10824. Bowlers awarded scholarship money will be notified by SMART on how to receive and use their funds.
10. **Dress Code:** **Bowlers must wear a bowling shirt with a collared, V-neck, rib-lined or banded necklines. Mock collar must be a minimum of ¾” (no t-shirts or shirts with any alcohol or tobacco advertising are allowed).** Male participants are required to wear slacks. Slacks must not contain drawstring waists or elastic bottoms. Slacks must have a zipper and a button to be eligible. Female participants are required to wear slacks, skirts, capris, skorts or walking shorts. All skirts, capris, skorts, or walking shorts must be below the competitor’s fingertips when they are standing and their arms are hanging loosely at their side. **Jeans and yoga pants are not permitted.** No visible midribs or exposed under garments. Any hats or headgear must be approved by the tournament director.
11. Only bowlers and tournament officials are allowed in the bowler area during the tournament. If a problem arises, all bowlers on the pair in question are to stop bowling and immediately call for a tournament official. Score corrections and other problems are to be directed to a tournament official for resolution.
12. All USBC codes of conducts will be enforced. Violation of said code may result in disqualification from the event.
13. Any rules not covered herein will be covered by USBC playing rules and specifications until the end of the 2017-2018 bowling season.
